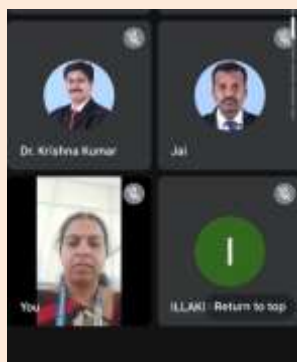
Research Scholar Presents AI-Based Power Study

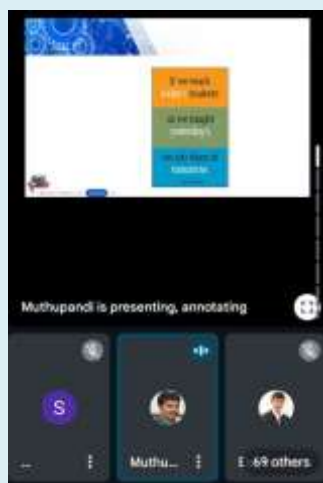
Faculty member Attends FDP on Generative AI
