



Industry-Oriented Laboratory Experiments Held for Medical Electronics Students

The Department of Medical Electronics conducted a series of industry-oriented laboratory experiments for the second-year students of the MDE programme as part of the course 23MDE301 – Electronic Devices & Circuits. The experiments were designed to provide students with practical exposure to electronic devices and circuits, bridging the gap between classroom learning and industrial applications. The programme focused on strengthening students' understanding of circuit design, testing, measurement and analysis through hands-on laboratory activities. The initiative aimed to equip students with practical skills relevant to the medical electronics industry and enhance their ability to apply theoretical concepts to real-world engineering challenges. The department stated that such industry-oriented laboratory activities would help students develop technical competency and gain greater exposure to current practices in the field of medical electronics.



An Anti-Drug Awareness Seminar was organised by the Anti-Drug Club (ADC), Sengunthar Engineering College (Autonomous), Tiruchengode, for the first-year students on 18 September 2026. The seminar was conducted with the theme “Understanding and Preventing Drug Abuse”, with the objective of creating awareness among students about the harmful effects of drug abuse and the importance of maintaining a healthy and responsible lifestyle. The session focused on the physical, psychological and social consequences of drug abuse, the risks associated with substance addiction, preventive measures, and the importance of seeking timely guidance and support. Elavarasan, ADC Coordinator, Sengunthar Engineering College (Autonomous), Tiruchengode. The seminar witnessed active participation from the first-year students and created awareness about the need for collective efforts in preventing drug abuse among the youth. The programme concluded with a message encouraging students to make informed choices, support their peers, and contribute towards building a healthy, safe and drug-free society.
